- We are unable to answer questions about donations or receive donations at the Parish Office.
- Please do not leave donated items outside the shop when it is closed.

Items that are popular with our customers include:

- Accessories: Hats, belts, shoes, jewelry, purses, pocketbooks.
- Vintage clothing, antiques, and collectibles.
- All clothing, especially in season, ladies, men's, and children's.
- Small furniture and pictures
- Small, working, kitchen and household appliances.
- Kitchen china and glassware.
- Decorative household items.
- Toys, in safe and usable condition.
- New (unopened) bedding and linens.
- Hardback and paperback books.

Due to safety and Health Department regulations, and limitations on space at our premises, we are unable to accept the following items. If you further questions, please contact us and we can discuss your planned donation further.

The following is a partial list of items we are unable to accept:

- Anything that is dirty, stained, torn, broken, chipped, or unhygienic.
- Used swimwear, underwear, and socks.
- Broken or unusable electronics.
- Cribs, car seats, and strollers, that do not meet the latest safety requirements and standards.
- Mattresses, box springs, and bed pillows.
- Large appliances.
- Walkers, or other medical aids, usually prescribed by a doctor.
- No weapons, of any kind.
- Outdated sporting equipment.
