These include canned meats (chicken, tuna, spam), canned fruits and vegetables, rice and pasta dishes, instant potatoes, soups, small condiment containers, small cereal boxes, peanut butter, jellies, evaporated milk, fruit drinks, spaghetti sauces, hashes and stews, and macaroni and cheese.

Currently we DO NOT NEED any boxes of dried pasta (spaghetti, noodles) or canned pinto or black beans. All other items are in high demand.



Persons visiting our Food Closet, are only able to

take two plastic bags of food, and only one of each item. Please donate items in regular sized cans.

Plan on making a visit to your local supermarket or dollar store. With your help we can give the less fortunate a good start in the new year.


